A Forever-Home Rescue Foundation is a non-profit, all-breed cat and dog rescue that works to find loving new "Forever Homes" for cats and dogs that have found themselves in a situation where they need help.

A Forever Home is made up of a group of experienced rescuers that take dogs and cats in from many harmful and neglectful situations such as puppy mills, backyard breeders, kill shelters plus animals who are surrendered by

their owners due to various life events that prevent them from keeping their pets. All the animals received are given a full health check-up by licensed veterinarians, and anything they need from spay/neutering, teeth cleaning, vaccinations, and any and all surgeries that may be required are done and paid for by the rescue. The rescue depends on a network of foster volunteers who take in these animals and keep them in their homes to socialize and take care of them until they are adopted. The adoption process is simple. If you see a dog or cat you are interested in, you can go online and fill out an adoption application for the particular animal. The applications are considered on a first come, first served basis. If your application is accepted, the rescue will contact you for an interview and a volunteer will come to your residence for a home check. Once these are completed, the adopter signs the adoption contract

and pays the adoption fee at which point he/she becomes the official guardian of the animal. You can see the adoptable pets and more information about the rescue at www.aforeverhome.org.

As part of our community outreach and education program, AFH conducts educational seminars at local schools, community centers, and other locations. These seminars focus on a wide variety of topics of benefit to the pet owner, the prospective pet owner, and the community at large. The seminars are conducted by AFH volunteers as well as by professionals contracted by AFH and are scheduled as requested.
